FAMILY SUPPORT & REUNIFICATION

- Reunity Houses** - therapeutic supervised visitation programs in South Orange, East Orange, and Paterson, dedicated to reuniting healthy families following separation due to child abuse or neglect.
- Supportive Visitation Services** - home-based therapeutic supervised visitation and support services throughout Passaic, Morris, and Sussex Counties
- Foster Healing** - evidence-based trauma-informed treatment for foster children and their caregivers
- HomeSafe** - supportive housing, counseling and care management in Essex, Passaic, and Hudson Counties, for families in which parents have a history of co-occurring substance abuse and mental illness.
- Foster Care Support Services** - holistic, in-home counseling for children and foster parents to maximize successful long-term placements.
- Community Case Management** - in-home clinical case management and linkage to services to prevent child abuse and family breakdown.
- Adolescent Crisis Intervention Program (ACIP)** - intensive in-home counseling for teenagers dealing with high-risk behaviors and/or family conflict.

SERVICES FOR AT-RISK YOUTH

- Family Crisis Intervention Program (FCIP)** - crisis stabilization and counseling services for children and families referred by Family Court and the community.
- Safe Journeys** - prevention and treatment for youth charged with inappropriate sexual behavior.
- OTARY (Outreach to At-Risk Youth)** - group-based youth counseling to prevent pregnancy, violence, gang involvement, and other high-risk behaviors.
- Clean&Cool** - a comprehensive, evidence-based program of substance abuse treatment and life skills training for high-risk teenagers.

MENTAL HEALTH & ADDICTION SERVICES

- Integrated Outpatient Treatment** - comprehensive evidence-based services, including bi-lingual services, for adults living with mental illness, addiction, or both.
- Wellness House** - intensive outpatient treatment and support services for adults living with serious and persistent mental illness and co-occurring disorders.
- StrongMothers & StrongFathers** - gender-specific intensive outpatient (IOP) substance abuse treatment enhanced with parenting and life skills training.
