## Who We Are

Family Connections' Older Adult Services offer three different programs focusing on older adults, individuals caring for older adults, and older adults who have become legal guardians to their grandchildren. The various programs include assessments, case management, resource sharing, group-based skill-building and counseling.

### **Program Highlights:**

- Increased access and knowledge of services available to older adults and their caregivers
- Increased ability for older adults to advocate for themselves
- Skill development to support taking preventative measures to improve overall health
- · Increased knowledge on how to manage health
- Increased desire to make healthy and safe lifestyle changes
- Improved coping skills for caregivers and older adults



### What We Do

# Older Adults Services are comprised of three programs:

- Outreach/Care Management In-home and community-based care management and linkage to services for older adults in Essex County to help them get the supports they deserve to remain independent.
- Caregivers Connection In home and nearhome counseling, advocacy, education, and care management for both caregivers of older adults (60 and above) and older adult caregivers (60 and above) who are legal guardians to their grandchildren throughout Essex County.
- **Health Education** Evidence-based workshops delivered throughout Essex County to preserve the independence and improve the health and wellbeing of older adults. These workshops include: Chronic Disease Self-Management, Diabetes Self-Management and A Matter of Balance (falls prevention).



### Results

#### Participants in Older Adult Services:

- Develop stronger coping skills to manage life's daily stressors
- Learn new self-care techniques to support mental, emotional, and physical well-being
- Understand how to manage chronic health conditions
- · Report a decreased fear of falling
- Have an increased awareness of services available to them
- · Feel more hopeful about their future
- Feel more confident in addressing their self-identified goals
