Welcome to Wellness House. We are an Intensive Outpatient Treatment Program (IOP) for Essex County adults living with mental illness, including those with co-occurring substance use or developmental disabilities. Here you'll experience comfort, convenience and professionalism in an environment designed to help you maximize your independence. We believe in you and we will treat you with respect.

Wellness House promises:

- People with serious and persistent mental illness will be treated as full partners in their care;
- Services will be customized to the individual and delivered with respect and hope;
- Services will include all necessary components for each consumer to achieve maximum independence and integration in his/her community. These principles and all program components are based on the Wellness and Recovery model of the New Jersey Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services.



What We Do

Wellness House participants receive 9 to 12 hours of services per week, including:

- Individualized Treatment Planning
- Individual Therapy
- Family Therapy, if desired
- Psychiatric Services & Medication Management
- Therapeutic, Psycho-Educational and Skills-Building Groups
- Co-Occurring Substance Use Treatment, if needed
- Life Enhancement Activities
- Case Management and Assistance with Concrete Needs
- Transportation Assistance
- Healthy Meals

- Have a diagnosis of severe and persistent mental illness, with or without substance use.
- Are 18 years of age or older
- Are willing and able to participate in their treatment and their Wellness/Recovery Action Plan
- Are not a danger to self or others or at imminent risk of a medical crisis
- Are assessed as able to be safely served in an outpatient setting
- Reside in Essex County
