As a Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC), we provide person and family-centered, comprehensive services in a single location. Individuals and families have access to outpatient and intensive outpatient mental health and substance use treatment and support services.



What We Do

Center St. location, individuals and families will have access to a comprehensive collection of culturally and linguistically appropriate services, regardless of their ability to pay or their place of residence.
