WHAT are STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES?

- NJ4S-Essex delivers a comprehensive Service Menu of Evidence Based Practices to inspire student success in school and life. Services include individual and group supports for children, teens, their parents, and their educators all to strengthen:
 - Social and emotional wellness
 - Substance use prevention
 - Healthy connections with peers
 - Understanding and coping with trauma including racial trauma
 - Mental health/wellbeing
 - Sexual health and pregnancy prevention
 - Suicide prevention
 - Anti-bullying and violence prevention
 - Support for LGBTQIA+ youth
 - Other needs identified by students, parents, and schools

services include universal prevention education for students, parents, and school staff in **grades pre-K-12**.

services include more focused group prevention programs for students, parents, and educators in **grades 6-12**.

Tier 3

services include individual and group mental health assessment and counseling for students and families in grades 6-12, plus linkage to ongoing treatment.







WHERE and WHEN?

NJ4S-Essex includes 50 specially trained prevention and mental health professionals with lived experience in the cultures, languages, and communities we serve. This team is deployed on-site at participating public/charter schools and other community centers.

Each site can pick the services they need from our Service Menu and choose the best times to maximize student and parent access. We operate before, during, and after school, including evenings, weekends, and throughout the summer.
