Family Connections' Parents as Teachers (PAT) is an evidence-based program which follows a national home visiting model. PAT provides family services, education, and peer support for parents – from pregnancy through early childhood, with the goal of nurturing children's healthy development and school readiness.

Parents as Teachers Program Goals:

- · Prevent child abuse and neglect
- Provide parents with the opportunity to discuss parenting challenges while also gaining an understanding of the strategies needed to find solutions
- Create healthy, strong, and resilient families through support and resources
- Provide opportunities for parents to connect with their children through play and reading time
- Increased knowledge of early childhood developmental delays and health issues
